When writing a story:

- use paragraphs
- use a variety of narrative tenses (past simple, past continuous..)
- use time linkers (when, while, as, as soon as...) *As soon as we got there, we went down to the river.*
- use adjectives / adverbs (surprised, frightened, upset, worried....)
- use questions and exclamations to make your story more interesting. *Steve shouted: „Look over there!”, „What is it?” I screamed. „It looks like.....*
